SITE INFORMATION

All sites are smoke free and most do not allow food in the classrooms. Some sites have vending machines and most sites have restaurants nearby. PLEASE OBSERVE ALL PARKING INSTRUCTIONS. We recommend bringing a sweater or sweatshirt for personal comfort of varying facility temperatures.

Elmbrook Church – 777 S Barker Road, Brookfield 53045

Take I-94 and US 18 (Bluemound Road). Turn south onto Barker Road for approximately 1 mile. The Church is on the west side of the street. Park and enter at the North Entry near the Garden of Readn'. <http://www.elmbrook.org>

Franklin High School – 8222 South 51st Street, Franklin 53132

The school is located between Drexel Ave (to the north) and Puetz Ave. (to the south). It is about 1.5 miles south of Rawson Ave. Exit I-94 at Rawson Ave., proceed west on Rawson Ave to 51 St., turn south on 51 St to the school. Park in front of the main doors.

Greendale High School – 6801 Southway, Greendale 53219

Take I-43 / I-894 and exit WI-36 W / W Loomis Road via Exit 8A. Drive 2.4 miles and turn right onto Southway.

Hales Corners Lutheran Elementary School – 5425 South 111th Street, Hales Corners 53130

Take Hwy 100 South to W. Grange Ave. Turn west on W. Grange Ave. Turn right on S. 112th. Follow to Hales Corners Elementary School on right side. Park on 112th St. in the angle parking. Computer lab is upstairs.

MATC Mequon Campus – 5555 West Highland Road 128N, Mequon 53092

The campus is just east of Green Bay Road on Highland. Use the Mequon Road (Hwy 167) exit from I-43; take Port Washington Road north to Highland Road and west to campus. From the west, take 76th Street or Green Bay Road north to Highland and east to campus. Use the parking lot on the east side of the building.

MATC Oak Creek Campus – 6665 S Howell Avenue, Oak Creek 53154

The campus is just south of College Avenue and about one mile east of I-94. Enter the campus from 5th and College or from Howell Avenue. Use upper Parking Lot C, east of the Main Building, or lower Lot B, south of the Main Building. Permits will be issued in class and should be placed on car dashboards no later than 1:00 pm.

Pleasant View Elementary School – 4601 West Marquette Avenue, Franklin 53132

The school is located near Rawson Avenue and South 51st Street. From this intersection, take Rawson Ave. east three blocks. Turn south (right) onto South 46th Street. Marquette Street is at the end of South 46th Street (approximately three blocks). Enter at west gym parking lot.

St. John Lutheran School – 7877 North Port Washington Road, Milwaukee 53217

Take I-43 north exit at Good Hope Road heading east. Immediately turn left (north) on Port Washington Road.
