TIMES & ATTENDANCE:

Three Credit Courses

One Week Courses: Monday – Friday 7:30 am – 4:30 pm

Students are expected to attend all sessions and be on time for class every day. McPherson College and Wisconsin DPI require a minimum of 750 contact minutes for each semester credit earned (2,250 for three-credit courses). If you have a conflict with your class schedule, contact Lorraine Lahdenpera at 262-549-2180. Tardiness and absences may result in an “incomplete” grade. The instructor(s) schedule breaks and lunches. Students will receive a course outline and time frame the first day of class.

CANCELLATIONS & LATE PAYMENTS: Full refunds are made for courses dropped at least two weeks prior to the starting date. Cancellations and payments received less than two weeks before the start of class will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. **Students may cancel registrations online through their student account or contact McPherson College by mail, fax or email to cancel courses.**

SITE INFORMATION

All sites are smoke free and most do not allow food in the classrooms. Some sites have vending machines and most sites have restaurants nearby. PLEASE OBSERVE ALL PARKING INSTRUCTIONS. We recommend bringing a sweater or sweatshirt for personal comfort of varying facility temperatures.

Center for Leadership Excellence – N4W22000 Bluemound Road, Waukesha 53186

From west of Waukesha: Take I-94 east to 294 exit (Hwy 164). Turn right at the stoplight and left at Bluemound Rd. From east of Waukesha: Take I-94 west to 297 exit. Turn right at Kossow Road and left on Bluemound Rd. The facility is located on the northwest corner of Bluemound Road and Springdale Road. Park and enter the building through the north side of the building.

Hales Corners Lutheran Middle School – 12300 West Janesville Road, Hales Corners 53130

At the intersection of Hwy 100 and Janesville Road, go west on Janesville Rd and the church is about one mile down on the right. Park towards the bottom of hill and enter on the lower level which is the Community Center. Follow the signs from there. If you enter through the main entrance, go left and down the stairs.

MATC Mequon Campus – 5555 West Highland Road 128N, Mequon 53092

The campus is just east of Green Bay Road on Highland. Use the Mequon Road (Hwy 167) exit from I-43; take Port Washington Road north to Highland Road and west to campus. From the west, take 76th Street or Green Bay Road north to Highland and east to campus. The campus is under construction; therefore, be sure to park in the EAST lot and use the EAST entrance to the building.

MATC Oak Creek Campus – 6665 South Howell Avenue, Oak Creek 53154

The campus is just south of College Avenue and about one mile east of I-94. Enter the campus from 5th and College or from Howell Avenue. Use upper Parking Lot C, east of the Main Building, or lower Lot B, south of the Main Building. **Note:** NO Parking Passes are required this year at MATC Oak Creek Campus.

Northwoods – 1572 East Capitol Drive, Shorewood 53211

From I-43, exit east on Capitol Drive (190). Head east for approximately 1.5 miles. The Northview building is two blocks west of North Oakland Avenue on the north side of Capitol Drive.

St. John's Lutheran School – 7877 North Port Washington Road, Glendale 53217

Take I-43, exit east on the Brown Deer Road exit and south on North Port Washington Road or go east on the Good Hope Road exit and north on North Port Washington Road. St. John's is on the west side of the street between Calumet Road and Bradley Road. The classroom is on the upper level – follow signs.
